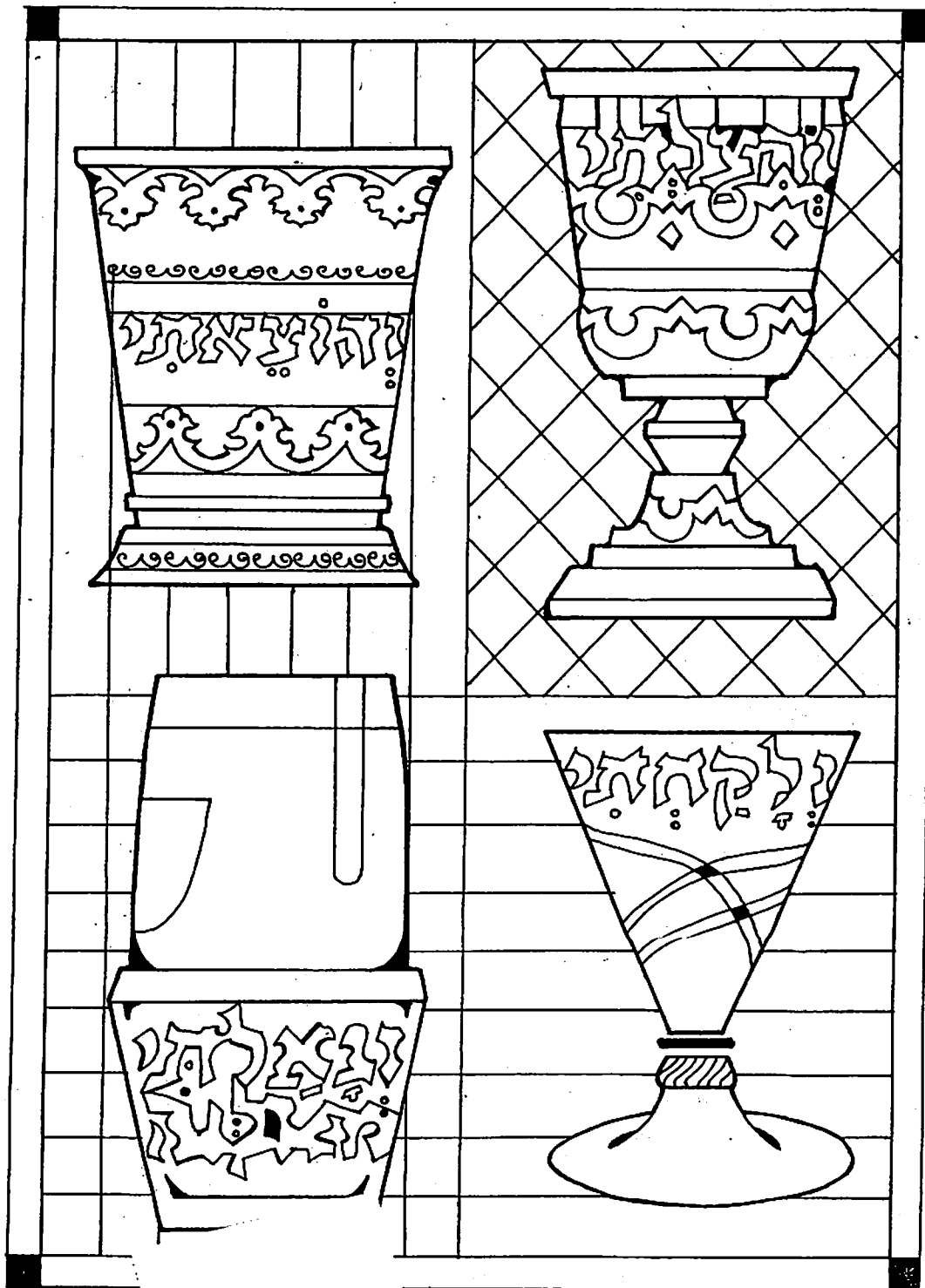


We drink four cups of wine at the Seder because the Torah mentions four ways in which God promised to free the Jewish people from slavery.

Each of the cups below has one of those promises in Hebrew letters.

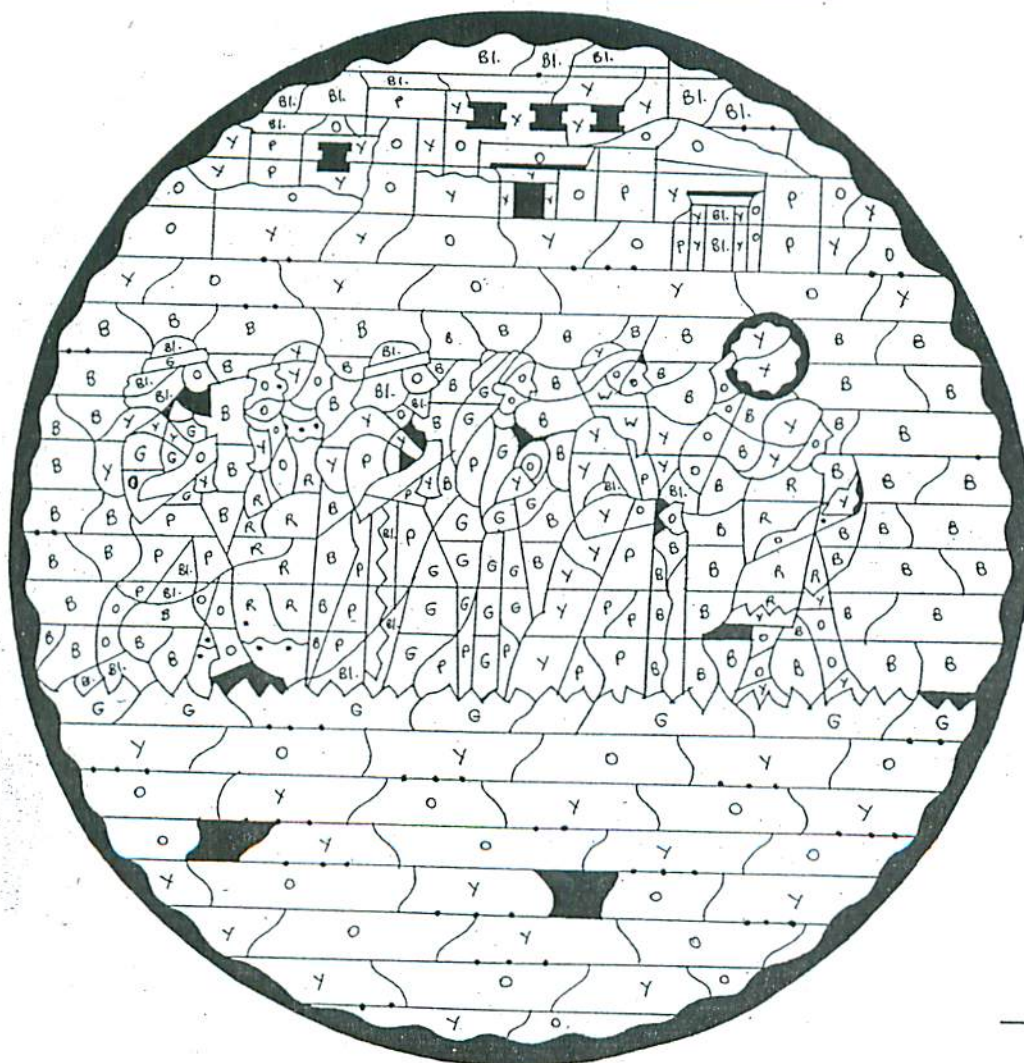
